SOUTH STREET / EASTERN ROAD TRAFFIC SIGNALS - PROPOSED CYCLE CROSSING FACILITIES

Havering Council is looking for your views on revised proposals to improve facilities for cycling, such as traffic signals and junctions in the South Street and Eastern Road area, Romford.

The proposals have been made following a review of comments received in a previous consultation in December 2021.

Revised proposals

(1) Havana Close

- (a) No Entry except cycles at the Exchange Street junction
- (b) Traffic island at the Exchange Street Junction.
- (c) Advisory contra flow cycle lane
- (d) Relocation of taxi bays
- (e) Introduction of a new motorcycle bay (30minutes No return within 30minutes)
- (f) 'At any time' waiting and loading restrictions

(2) South Street

- (a) No Entry except buses and cycles at the Havana Close Junction
- (b) A segregated contra flow cycle lane with minor carriageway widening
- (c) Existing loading bay to be changed to 'Goods vehicles only' loading bay (1 hour no return within 2 hours)

(3) South Street / Eastern Road Traffic Signals

The traffic signals are to be re-designed to accommodate cycle crossing facilities

- (4) Eastern Road
- (a) 'No Entry except cycles' at the South Street junction
 - (b) A segregated two-way cycle lane with the centre island
 - (c) 'At any time' waiting and loading restrictions
 - (d) Taxi bays
 - (i) The Taxi bays closest to Romford Station to be reduced from 27metres to 21meters
 - (ii) Taxi bays at the Chandlers Way junction to be removed
 - (iii) Existing taxi bays outside Nos.12-16 to be extended from 10metres to 19metres
 - (e) No Entry except buses, taxis and cycles at the Chandlers Way Junction
 - (f) Removal of traffic island at the Chandlers Way junction and provide a priority junction
- (5) Chandlers Way
- Humped zebra crossing with cycle crossing facilities and footway extension at the Eastern Road junction
- (6) Victoria Road / South Street Junction and railway bridge
- (a) Existing motorised vehicles including motor cycles (except for access) prohibited
Sign to be replaced with motorised vehicles except solo motorcycles (except for access) prohibited
sign as shown
 - (b) New motorised vehicles except buses, taxis and loading by goods vehicles prohibited and 'Restricted Parking Zone signs at the railway bridge as shown

Please note I am unable to answer individual points raised at this stage.

However, your comments will be noted and will be taken into consideration when presenting the final report to the Lead Member for Environment and any issues will be addressed at that time.

All comments received are open to public inspection.

- a) Prohibition of motor vehicles except solo motor cycles except for access on South Street from its junction with Victoria Road
- b) Amend the existing restricted parking zone to restricted parking zone (no waiting at any time) except in signed bays on South Street from outside No 139/143 to the rear of the flank wall of No 89 South Street and into the junction of Havana Close
- c) Prohibition of motor vehicles except solo motorcycles except buses, taxis and for loading by goods vehicles from outside No 139/143 South Street
- d) Havana Close no entry except cycles from its junction with Exchange Street.
- e) Installation of an advisory contra flow cycle lane in Havana Close along the flank wall of No 106 South Street
- f) Existing taxi bay in Havana Close to be relocated towards its junction with South Street and replaced with no waiting and no loading at any time restrictions
- g) Installation of motorcycle bay maximum stay 30 minutes, no return within 30 minutes in Havana Close
- h) Extension of no loading at any time restrictions in the contra flow cycle lane in Havana Close
- i) Installation of no loading at any time restrictions in Havana Close from the motorcycle bay to its junction with South Street
- j) No entry except buses and cycles on South Street after its junction with Havana Close
- k) Installation of a mandatory contra flow cycle lane on South Street from its junction with Havana Close to outside No 131 South Street
- l) Amendment to existing loading bay on South Street outside No 112/116 to goods vehicles loading only, 1 hour no return within 2 hours
- m) Existing taxi bay in Eastern Road to be reduced outside No 2/4 and existing no waiting at any time restrictions extended and installation of no loading at any time restrictions
- n) Taxi bay outside No 6 Eastern Road to be removed and replaced with no waiting or loading at any time restrictions
- o) Extension of existing taxi bay outside No 12 / 16 Eastern Road, removing existing waiting restrictions
- p) Installation of the no loading restrictions on Eastern Road from its junction with Chandlers Way to outside No 3/5
- q) Existing no entry on Eastern Road near to its junction with Chandlers Way to change to no entry except buses, taxis and cycles
- r) Removal of part of the existing waiting and loading restrictions on Chandlers Way near to its junction with Eastern Road
- s) No entry except for cycles from South Street into Eastern Road
