The Rainham and Beam Park Regeneration LLP are proposing the development of three sites to include approximately 160 new residential units and the relocation of the Silver Hall Social Club, as well as associated landscape works.

The vision of the LLP is to transform the A1306 corridor from a declining industrial area into a vibrant, sustainable new urban community alongside the programme of infrastructure upgrades planned for the local area. The LLP has currently identified 9 strategic sites within the Rainham and Beam Park Housing Zone, all along the A1306 (New Road) corridor. Each site is subject to its own unique, yet linked planning application and identified in the Figure 1.

MASTERPLAN VISION AND PRINCIPLES

Rainham and Beam Park Planning Framework

Since June 2015, Rainham and Beam Park has been identified as one of the GLA's new 'Housing Zones'. To further this intention, the Rainham and Beam Park Planning Framework (RBPPF) was published in January 2016 to provide a guide for change. It includes an illustrative masterplan for the area of 144Ha, encompassing the historic heart of Rainham and extending west to include land along the New Road corridor including Beam Park.

The Planning Framework identifies six character areas that should be established. These are Rainham Village, Beam Park Centre, Park View Living, The Beam Gardens, Creekside and Beam Parkway.

"Beam Parkway" is set out to become a well enclosed urban corridor overlooked by residents.






